

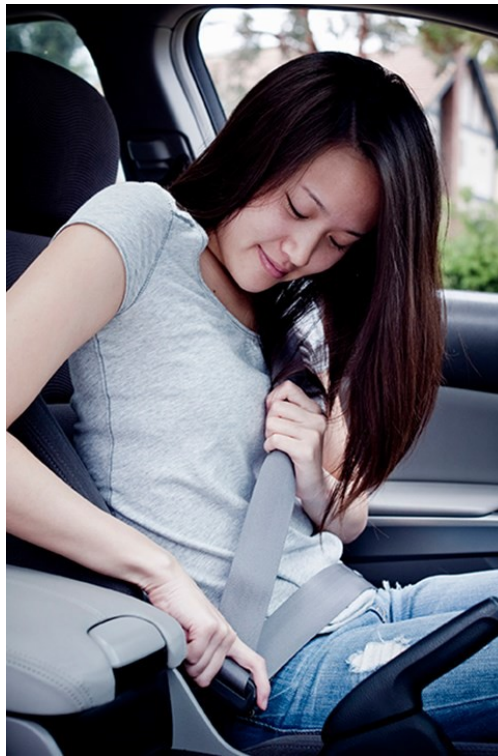


Attention PARENTS of New Teen Drivers

Any teen drivers who will be licensed as an intermediate driver and would like to attend the Checkpoints™ Program, 8/29/2019 @ 6:30. The training will be held at the Jessamine Career & Technology Center. This is approximately a one-hour program that is designed to reduce teen crashes. At least one parent or guardian must attend with the teen driver and jointly complete a parent-teen driving agreement to receive a discount on the student parking permit & other incentives.

New teen drivers are at greater risk for crashes when:

1. Driving during the first months without adult supervision
2. Driving at night
3. Driving with passengers
4. Driving on high speed roads
5. Driving in poor weather conditions
6. Driving on unfamiliar roads



Families who completed the Checkpoints™ program experienced:

1. An increase in the understanding of teen driving risks
2. Establishing guidelines to reduce risks beyond the Graduated Driver License Law
3. Written agreements to reduce teen driving risks
4. A reduction in risky teen driving behaviors

The goal of the Checkpoints program is to reduce teen crashes and violations received by teen drivers.

All students who currently have an INTERMEDIATE RESTRICTED Graduated Driver License are encouraged to register.
